SPRINGFIELD. HE ASKED IF THERE IS A SAFETY NET FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE NOT 100% HOMELESS, WORK BUT REQUIRE ASSISTANCE TO AFFORD HOUSING.

COMMSR CAULTON NOTED THAT WE ARE AT FULL CAPACITY. HOTELS ARE USED AS OVERFLOW SITES. SHE NOTED THAT THE CITY THROUGH THE FUNDING WE RECEIVE DO HAVE PROGRAMS THAT HELP INDIVIDUALS WHO MAY NOT BE ABLE TO AFFORD RENT.

COUNCILOR GOVAN NOTED HER CONCERNS ABOUT SPRINGFIELD BEING SADDLED WITH INDIVIDUALS FROM NEIGHBORING COMMUNITIES WHO NEVER RESIDED IN SPRINGFIELD. NOTED A SUGGESTION OF REACHING OUT TO OTHER COMMUNITIES TO "HELP" CARRY THE BURDEN.
