COUNCILOR WHITFIELD SPOKE ON THE ITEM TO AMEND BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING UPDATED LANGUAGE:

D. Except with respect to Section E below, upon the conclusion of Mr. Lawrence E. Akers' service to the City of Springfield as the Police Superintendent, the provision shall revert to the provision in effect immediately prior to this amendment.

E. The Board of Police Commissioners shall not forfeit their authority to hire, promote or discipline under the City Code, to the Police Superintendent, Police Chief, or any other individual, whether by memorandum of understanding, or any other means, unless such forfeiture of authority is approved by majority vote of the City Council. Notwithstanding the forgoing, nothing in this Section (E) shall be construed to impair or restrict the provisions of Article IV, Chapter 27, section 27-26 and Article XIX, Chapter 16, section 16-66.
