2. Nuisance and Dangerous Dog Hearing for Three (3) Dogs Named Lincoln, Ragnar and Sampson at 21 Wells St Owned by Ismael Toledo.

Read.

Renee Robichaud, Animal Control Officer for Thomas J. O'Connor (TJO) and Adoption Center read their reports.

Complainant

Mrs. Hodgson stated her and her husband was walking her dogs on leashes when their dogs was attacked. It was brutal. They have sent over \$4,500.00 so far, \$3,500 in vet and \$1,000.00 in rehabilitations. They have an appointment next week because the doctor think that the dog is going to need additional surgery, and it will cost between \$6,000 and \$8,000. She put a lot into making sure that her dog is not in a situation like this. The dogs came to her dogs, the dogs were loose, they were left loose in their backyard while the owners were not home. The fence was propped up with a tire. When the dog attacked her dog, she could not get the dog to stop. Her dog has a lot of loose skin and a huge scar. The main attacker is the brown dog with white. There are so many dogs in the neighborhood that are probably little dogs that are more vulnerable and there are kids. It feels dangerous. She wants safety. She's now dealing with the trauma; she is having a lot of trouble getting scared when she sees dogs.

Respondent

Ismael Toledo apologized to Mrs. Hodgson and said there is no excuse for the dogs getting out; it was his father-in-law who let the dogs get out, they are usually locked in. He said he will cover all the bills; and it's unfair for Mrs. Hodgson and the neighbors. The dogs haven't been out since. It was irresponsible.

Rebuttal

Board Member Edwards made a motion to deem the dog named Sampson as dangerous, and Lincoln and Ragnar as nuisance dogs the motion was seconded by Board Member Landry.

After review of the hearing testimonies and the Thomas J. O'Connor Animal Control and Adoption Center reports, the Committee has imposed the following conditions on Sampson:

1. That the owner post a clearly visible warning sign that informs people that there is a dangerous dog on the property, as described in c. 110 § 1 and in accordance with c. 110 § 10 of the Code;

2. That the owner or keeper of the dog provide proof of insurance in an amount not less than \$100,000 insuring the owner or keeper against any claim, loss, damage or injury to persons, domestic animals or property resulting from the acts, whether intentional or unintentional, of the dog or proof that reasonable efforts were made to obtain such insurance if a policy has not been issued; provided, however, that if a policy of insurance has been issued, the owner or keeper shall produce such policy upon request of the hearing authority or a justice of the district court; and provided further, that if a policy has not been issued the owner or keeper shall produce proof of efforts to obtain such insurance, in accordance with Massachusetts General Law (M.G.L.) c. 140 § 157(c)(iv) and c. 110 § 10 of the Code; and
3. That the owner or keeper of the dog provide to the licensing authority, information by which a dog may be identified, throughout its lifetime including, but not limited to, photographs, videos, veterinary examination, tattooing or microchip implantations or a combination of any such methods of identification, in accordance with M.G.L. c. 140 § 157(c)(v) and c. 110 § 10 of the Code.

After review of the hearing testimonies and the Thomas J. O'Connor Animal Control and Adoption Center reports, the Committee has imposed the following conditions on Sampson, Lincoln, and Ragnar:

1. That all three (3) dogs be neutered within six (6) months, in accordance with c.110 §10 of the Code;
2. That all three (3) dogs be licensed, in accordance with c.110 §10 of the Code;
3. That all three (3) dogs be muzzled (an Animal Control Officer will speak to the owner regarding the type of muzzle) when outdoors, both on and off the property, in accordance with c. 110 § 10 of the Code; and
4. That all three (3) dogs be confined when outside within a locked fence, in accordance with c. 110 §§ 8 and 10 of the Code. An Animal Control Officer will visit the property to view the fence and make recommendation(s) in accordance with c. 110 §§ 8 and 10 of the Code.

She looked and the dogs were circling her dog so she went over and told the dogs to go home, then they attacked her, they were jumping and snapping at her. She yelled for David, grab her dog and brought her dog in the house to make sure she was ok. She picked up her walking stick and began to walled to David house and told him what had happened to her. The dog was not at David's house, then the dogs came home and David says this is no more he's getting rid of the dogs. She can't walk her dog anymore or mowed her lawn without taking a big stick with her because she's afraid. This cant continues something needs to be done and somebody has to take responsibility. It is creating trauma in her life and it's not fair.

Respondent

David Benoit said he doesn't know what to say, he only knows about one incident. He will do whatever he needs to do.

Rebuttal

Cherly said she called TJO three (3) times and Mr. Benoit has been notified more than once.

Mr. Benoit said TJO came by twice.

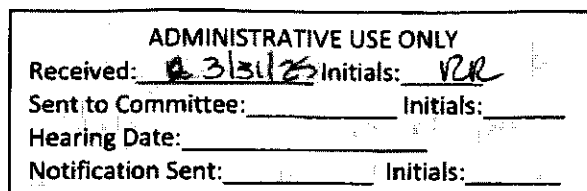

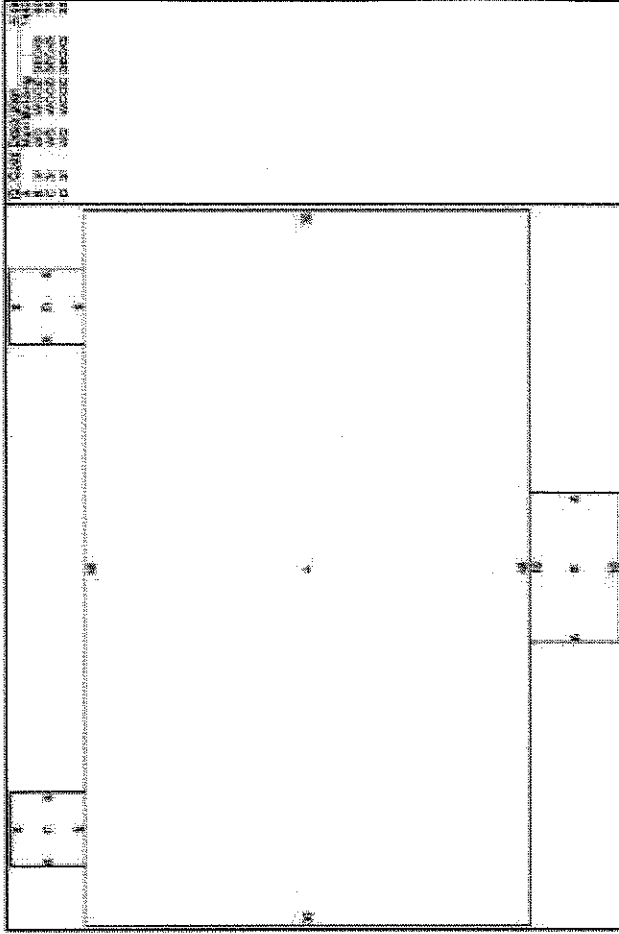

A dangerous dog hearing was held on June 26, 2025 by the Animal Control Advisory and Hearing Committee in accordance with Chapter 110, Section 10 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance, 2012, as amended for dangerous dog hearing for your pit bull dog. The committee voted to deem your dog as **Dangerous** and has imposed the following conditions:

The Advisory and Hearing Committee has imposed the following condition on the animal:

1. That the dog be humanely restrained. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-1 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.
2. That the dog be confined to the premises of the owner of the dog; provided, however, that "confined" shall mean securely confined indoors or confined outdoors in a securely enclosed and locked pen or dog run area upon the premises of the owner; provided however, that such confinement shall comply with § 110-8 of this chapter. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-2 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.
3. That whenever the dog is removed from the premises of the owner, the dog shall be securely and humanely muzzled and restrained with a leash having a minimum tensile strength of 300 pounds and not exceeding three feet in length. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-3 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.
4. That the animal shall be surgically sterilized and microchipped with the microchip registered to the City, with all costs associated with these services to be borne by the owner. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-4 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.
5. That ownership of the dog may not be transferred unless the transfer of ownership is to an adult residing within the same residence and said dog shall remain housed solely at that residence. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-6 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.
6. That, if the owner of the dog fails to appear at a hearing in front of the Advisory and Hearing Committee and the dog is declared a dangerous dog, the dog shall be impounded

and/or euthanized. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-7 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.

Failure to comply with this order may result in a fine of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for up to 60 days under Mass General Law Chapter 140 Section 157a. Please note transferring ownership or possession of your dog is prohibited under subsection (3) of Chapter 140 Section 157A

An appeal of this decision may be filed in District Court within 21 days of receiving this notice per Section 110-13(E) of the Springfield, MA ordinance. Further information regarding the requirement may be obtained from the Thomas J. O'Connor Animal Control Center, 627 Cottage Street, Springfield, Massachusetts, 413-781-1484.

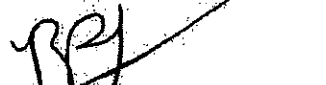

Attached hereto please an Activity Report of the incident. The dog is described as a grey, pit bull type dog, which was observed coming from your property.

If the dog is owned by you please be advised you will be sent notification of a dangerous dog hearing, which is tentatively scheduled for June 5, 2025. If the dog is owned by a tenant of yours, please contact me via telephone or email with their name and contact information so the owner may get proper notification of the above referenced dangerous dog hearing.

Please be advised Massachusetts caselaw has found landlords can be found responsible for the actions of their tenant's dogs. Factors include: whether the dog has dangerous propensities, and whether the landlord had notice that their tenant was keeping a dangerous dog. Please allow this correspondence to serve as notice of a potentially dangerous dogs living at 10-12 Sanderson Street, Springfield, MA 01107.

The committee had voted to deem your dog Mia as Nuisance at the December 19, 2024 dog hearing that was held and has imposed the following conditions:

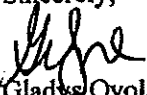
1. That the dog be humanely restrained. As defined in Chapter 110, Section 10-B-1 of the Code of the City of Springfield Ordinance.

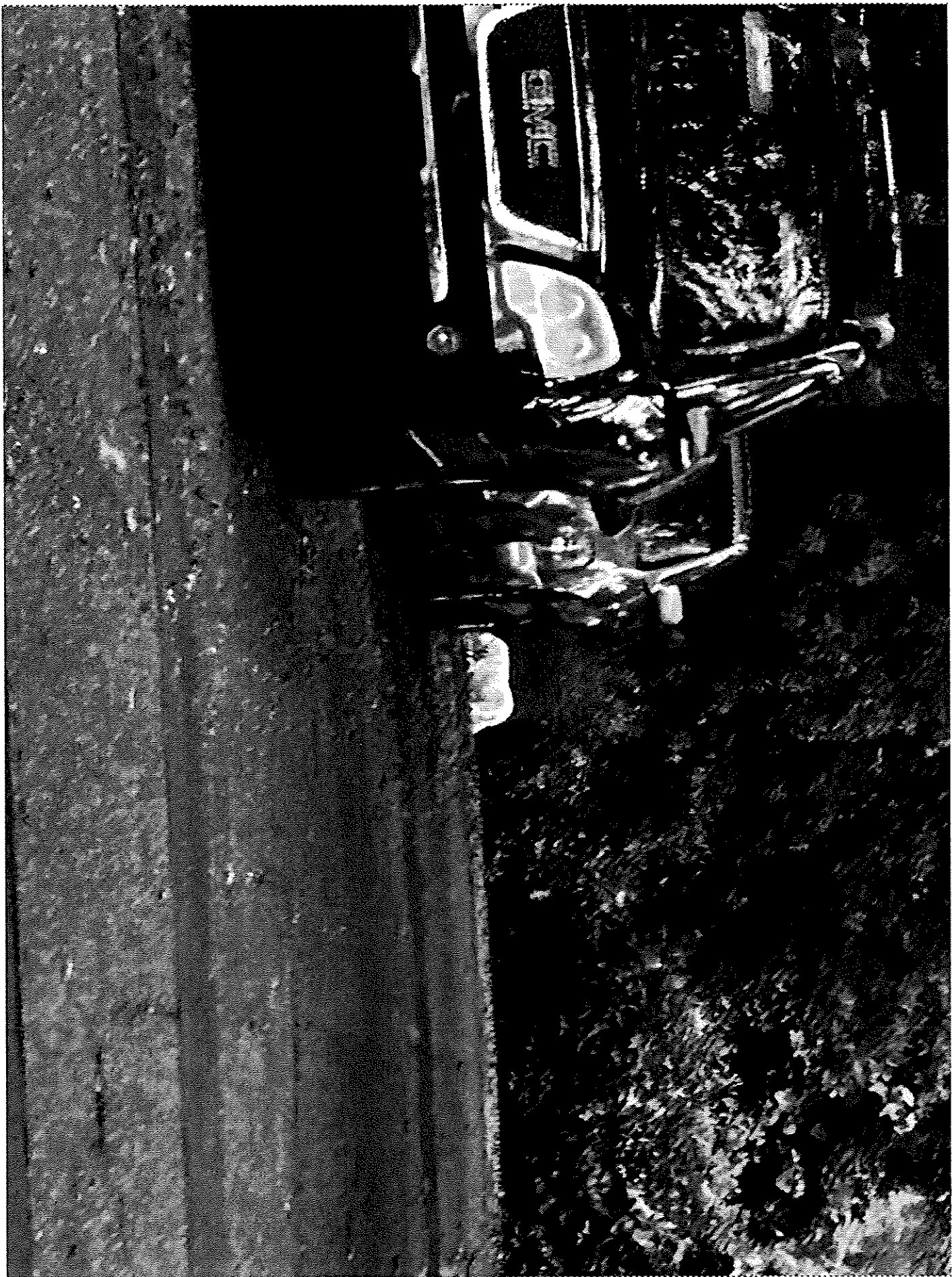

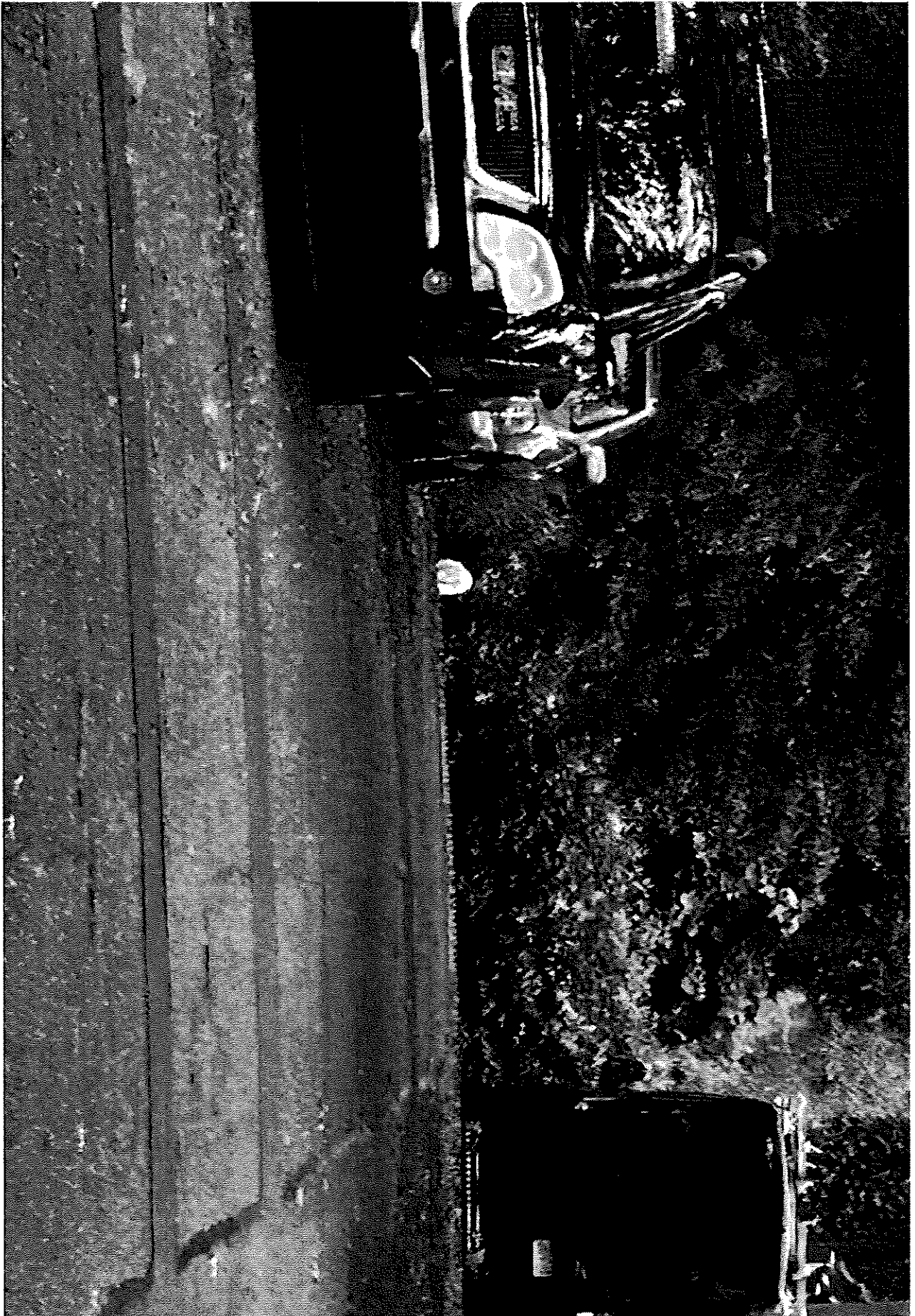

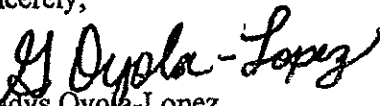
