The meeting was called to order on July 13, 2017 at 6:09 P.M. Commissioners: Peter Sygnator, Robert Casey, Andrew Cade, Ronald Senez and Rosa Espinosa were present. The meeting was held at Springfield City Hall, 36 Court Street - Room 220-2nd Floor, Springfield, MA.

FIRST order of business - Approval of Minutes:

Approval of Minutes for Springfield Board of License Commissioners Hearing held on Thursday, June 22, 2017.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to approve. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Casey with a unanimous vote to approve.

SECOND order of business: Petitions

Petition for a Change of Hours for Pride Stores, LLC dba Pride Food Court located at 77 West Street; Enrique Siu, Manager of Record.

Attorney James Channing appeared on behalf of the Licensee.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to extend hours of operation until 12; 30am with a 6 month follow up to reconsider extending to 24 hours. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Senez with a unanimous vote to approve.

THIRD order of business- Informational Hearing:

Bay Auto Sales Corp. d/b/a Bay Auto Sales located at 784 Bay Street; Argenis Ramos, Manager of Record- Incident of July 5, 2017.

Licensee appeared Pro Se.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to continue generally. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Cade with a unanimous vote to approve.

FOURTH order of business- Pre-Hearing Conferences:

Ramani, Inc. d/b/a Club Pendora located at 1534 State Street ; Kiesha E. Edmondson, Manager of Record; Incident of June 3, 2017 & June 4, 2017 - Allowing patrons to exit the licensed premise with alcohol (2 Counts); No Manager of Record on Scene (2 Counts); Violation of security plan- patrons loitering in the parking lot almost one hour after the stated closing time of 1:30am & non -working video cameras (2 Counts) ; Exterior signage does not display the proper dba (1 Count).

Licensee appeared Pro Se.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to agree to suspend the License until a new manager of record is appointed. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Casey with a unanimous vote to approve.
