Dangerous Dog Hearing

- Dangerous Dog Hearing on Two Dogs, "BlueJay" and "Ryder," Owned by Alton Llanos of 27 Riverview Street, Springfield. the Hearing is Being Requested by Animal Control Based on a Recent Incident Where the Dogs Escaped Their Yard and Chased a Woman and Her Dog, as Well as History of the Dogs Getting Loose and Acting Aggressively. Attached You Will Find a Summary of Events Involving the Dogs in Question, the Individual Activity Reports, License Copies and Proof of Breeding Occurring on the Property.**

COMMENTS - Current Meeting:

Thomas J O'Connor (T.J.O) received a complaint that BlueJay and Ryder got loose from their yard at 27 Riverview and chased a woman and her dog. When TJO arrived they saw two dogs with bite marks and a third dog covered in blood.

Shirley Rueli stated that her sister was attacked by two dogs. That they chased her and her puppy.

Crystal Lamb, the owner, said she never had anyone complain about her dog other than that they had been loose and that Alton was not home. Maurice Freeman said he didn't know the dog was loose until when he went to the front after hearing knocking on the door and a neighbor said the dog was loose. Mr Freedman put the dog inside and never saw the dog attack anyone.

After hearing the testimony the Board of Animal Control unanimously voted to deem the dogs as nuisance.

The following conditions were imposed: (1) that the dogs be microchipped and the chip registered to the City of Springfield (2) the owner must construct a secure enclosure for the dogs (3) owner must have a cement base cap kennel fence (4) the dogs must be spayed/Neutered (5) the owner must obtain \$100,000.00 insurance policy for each dog and the owner must file a copy of the insurance the city of Springfield (6) the dogs must be turned over to animal control.

3. Reconsideration of Dangerous Dog Determination by Chastity Lampro**COMMENTS - Current Meeting:**

Ms. Chasity Lampro stated her dogs Chevy and Alley have been to dog training classes with a licensed trainer, and both received their k-9 good citizens certificates. Chevy and Alley have been around other dogs and people with no issues. Ms Lampro, also stated that her other dog Penelope is attending socialization classes. Ms Lampro said her dogs Alley and Penelope are now on prozac because of separation anxiety.

After hearing Ms Lampro testimony the Board of Animal Control vote unanimously to not to take the dogs off of the dangerous dog list.

27 Riverview/Alton Llanos history

In 2007 TJO euthanized "Devious" owned by Alton Llanos after the dog was found inside an area home and the owner declined to retrieve him. Llanos has an outstanding bill at TJO for this service.

6/1/16-Officer Simpson went to 27 Riverview Street after receiving a complaint of 2 dogs fighting in a yard. Owner Llanos was not compliant or forthcoming with information during this visit and was cited. He was also reported to the MSPCA for concerns over lack of vet care for the dogs' injuries.

10/28/16-Animal Control received a complaint of 2 loose pit bulls in the area of Riverview Street, both were gone on arrival.

12/10/16-Both dogs, "BlueJay" and "Ryder," owned by Llanos, were picked up loose, impounded at TJO and returned to co-owner Crystal Lamb for \$380 (impound, board, leash law and spay/neuter violation, both dogs were current on rabies vaccinations and licensed at the time).

7/11/17-Animal Control received an online complaint that both dogs, "BlueJay" and "Ryder," got loose from their fenced yard at 27 Riverview and chased a woman and her dog. Owner Llanos cited again for leash law violations.

Llanos currently has the two adult dogs, "BlueJay" and "Ryder," and 3 puppies from their last litter. His yard is fully fenced and he has some locking mechanism(s) on the door. The adult dogs are licensed under Crystal Lamb but current on rabies under Alton Llanos in Tracker. Neither dog is spayed or neutered.

Officer Simpson arrived at 27 Riverview Street after a neighbor called Springfield Police about dogs fighting and the owner being bitten. The neighbor had heard the owner yelling and saying "throw hot water on that bitch." Upon arrival Officer Simpson noticed the owner Alton Llanos in the back yard with a towel taped around his right forearm. When asked about the injury Llanos claimed to have cut it on his car. Officer Simpson also observed 2 blue and white pitbull type dogs in the yard, one intact male and one intact female. The male appeared to be soaked with water and the female had several fresh puncture wounds on her chest and face. When asked if his dogs were licensed and vaccinated Llanos said "yes" and that he does it all himself at a clinic in South Hadley. Officer Simpson explained that if Llanos was not a vet he could not administer rabies vaccines and then tried to inform the owner of the home quarantine process. Llanos then became agitated saying no one was taking his dogs. Simpson again tried to explain home quarantine procedure and that the dogs would not be removed from the property, at which time Llanos stated "get the fuck off the property." Officer Simpson then left and completed the bite report despite Llanos's claim that there was no bite.

When Officer Simpson returned to the office an anonymous caller had left a message stating there was a 3rd white pitbull type dog with severe cuts that was hidden inside Llanos's home. Officer Simpson did not see this dog during the visit but informed Officer Christine Allenberg of the MSPCA of the situation for a follow up visit. An incomplete bite report was sent to Steve Stathis of the Springfield Board of Health. Llanos was issued a citation for 3 unlicensed and unvaccinated dogs (\$50 per violation, per dog) in accordance with 110-2, totaling \$300, citation # 207255. DogTracker lists 2 male pit bull type dogs to Llanos, named "BlueJay" and "Rider," both dogs are current on rabies and were licensed for 2016 on 11/22/16 (after the citations were issued).

Officer Mateo, stopped by this address after being notified about a possible dog bite incident yesterday via an online post sent from a TJO volunteer. Around 10:00 AM on 7/10/17 the 2 dogs from 27 Riverview, BlueJay and Ryder, owned by Alton Llanos, got loose and went after a person who was walking her dog. This person was later identified as Elizabeth Gurka at 13-885-6368, 47 Riverview, Springfield. During the altercation Gurka was walking her dog and was knocked down by Llanos's loose dogs. They also chased her and her puppy to her home. No bite occurred. Gurka has been advised of her right to request a dangerous or nuisance hearing on the dogs involved.

Spoke to Mr. Alton Llanos, who was aware of the incident, on 7/11/17 at his home. According to him, the little dog did not suffer any wounds. It appears that his male dog broke the latch on the gate and both dogs got loose. He fixed the latches, he said. He also said that he put multiple latches on the fence to prevent this from happening again.

In the past Mr. Alton has easily become upset when any Animal Control Officer had been to his property inquiring about his dogs. He blames the neighbors for calling and made some remarks about race. He states that since he bought that house some neighbors just complain, but none are the immediate neighbors, referring to the two neighbors right next to his property. Mr. Llanos has a new wooden fence all around his rear yard. He currently has three puppies left from the last litter which appear to be about 4 months old. He mentioned he never had any neighbor issues with his dogs at his former residence by East Street in Springfield. He is also planning to build a kennel for the dogs in his yard by the end of this summer.

Made him aware that we have received multiple complaints from the neighborhood and residents being scared about his dogs. We talked about breed, size, and how some people are simply afraid of dogs, as well as his goals and responsibilities to prevent any further issue is to keep his dogs in his property. EM

In accordance with provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 140 and the City of Springfield Code, 2012, as amended, Chapter 110 a license is hereby issued to the person named above to keep the dog herein described for one (1) year from the first day of April of each year. Each dog is numbered and registered as required by said laws, for which the required payment has been paid

RABIES

RABIES - Rabies is a disease caused by a germ in the saliva of a "Mad" dog. The germs enter the body through the wound made when a rabid animal bites another animal or person.

SYMPTOMS - Rabies may appear in either the dumb or the furious form. The symptoms are not constant, but as a rule dogs with DUMB RABIES are very RESTLESS. The eyes taken on a peculiarly bright appearances, with dilated pupils. The dogs may be more AFFECTIONATE than usual. The throat and jaws gradually become paralyzed so that MOUTH HANGS OPEN, saliva DROOLS out, and the tongue seems to be in the way. There is difficulty in swallowing. Frequently these symptoms lead to the mistake of thinking the animal has a BONE CAUGHT in the throat. The dog may snap at imaginary objects.

Dogs affected with the FURIOUS form of RABIES become IRRITABLE and restless, SNAPPING at people or other animals. They will chew up foreign material such as rugs, pieces of clothing, or wood. They try to get out of the house to run. If confined, they will TEAR at objects and, if they break loose, will RUN AIMLESSLY for miles, snapping and biting at any moving objects crossing their path.

In both forms of rabies, there is a peculiar high pitched and HOUND LIKE HOWL. The end comes when the dog is exhausted, the legs become paralyzed, and the dog dies in a stupor. RABIES NEVER APPEAR AS SUDDEN CONVULSIONS OR FITS.

IF A DOG BITES A PERSON - Do NOT kill it. Confine the dog and call a veterinarian. The dog should be kept under observation. If it remains well, there is no danger of rabies to animals or persons bitten; if it has rabies, definite symptoms and death will occur within the two weeks' period of restraint that is required. If the dog is killed at once, you may never know whether or not it was rabid.

ALL PERSONS BITTEN BY OR INTIMATELY EXPOSED TO RABID ANIMALS SHOULD BE GIVEN ANTI-RABIC TREATMENT

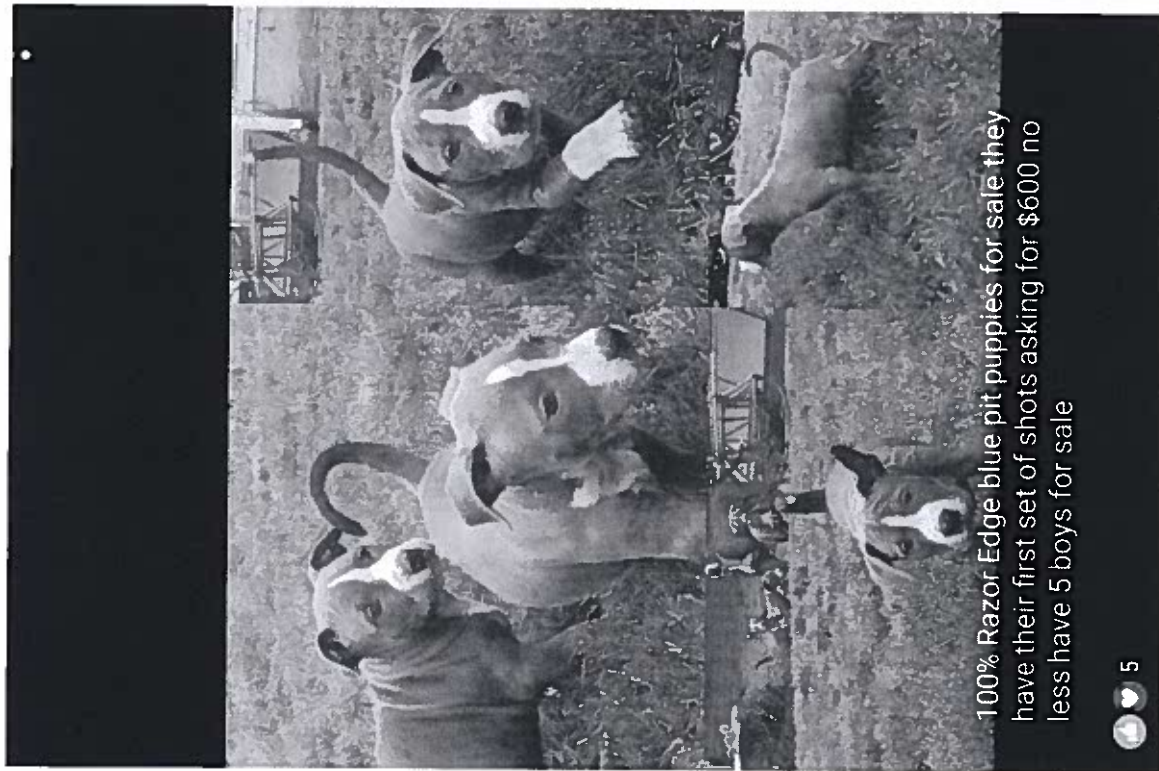

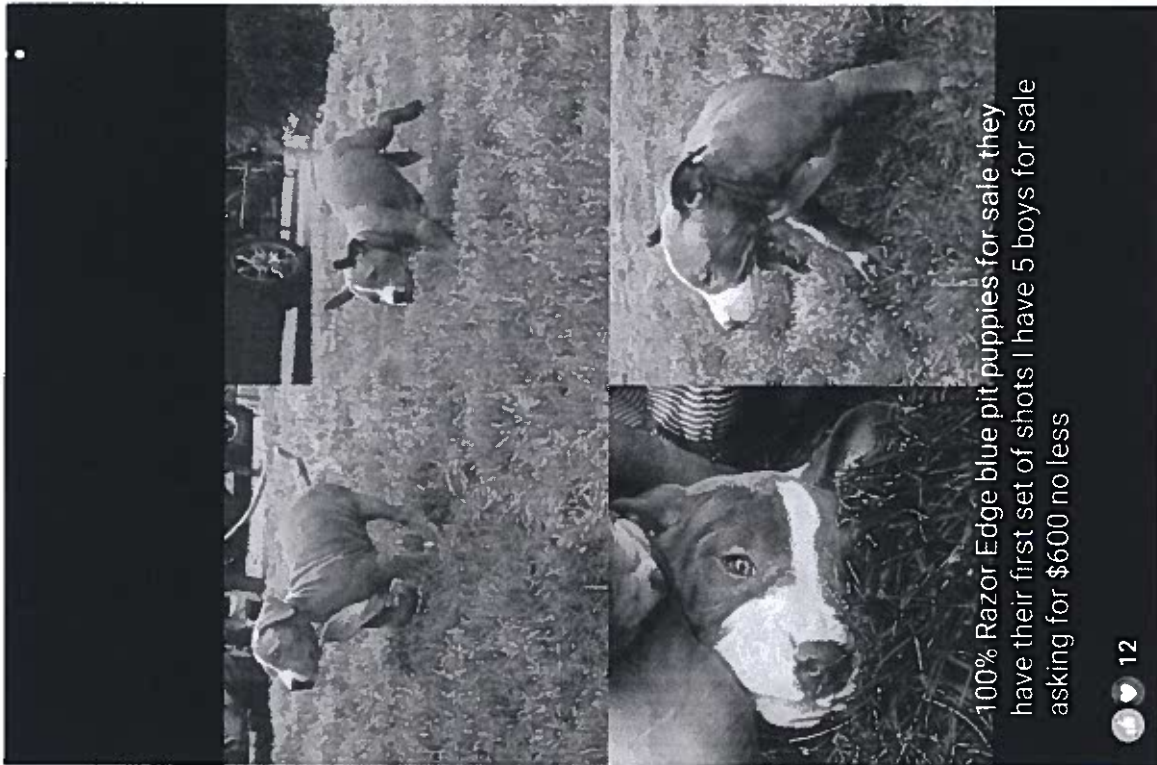

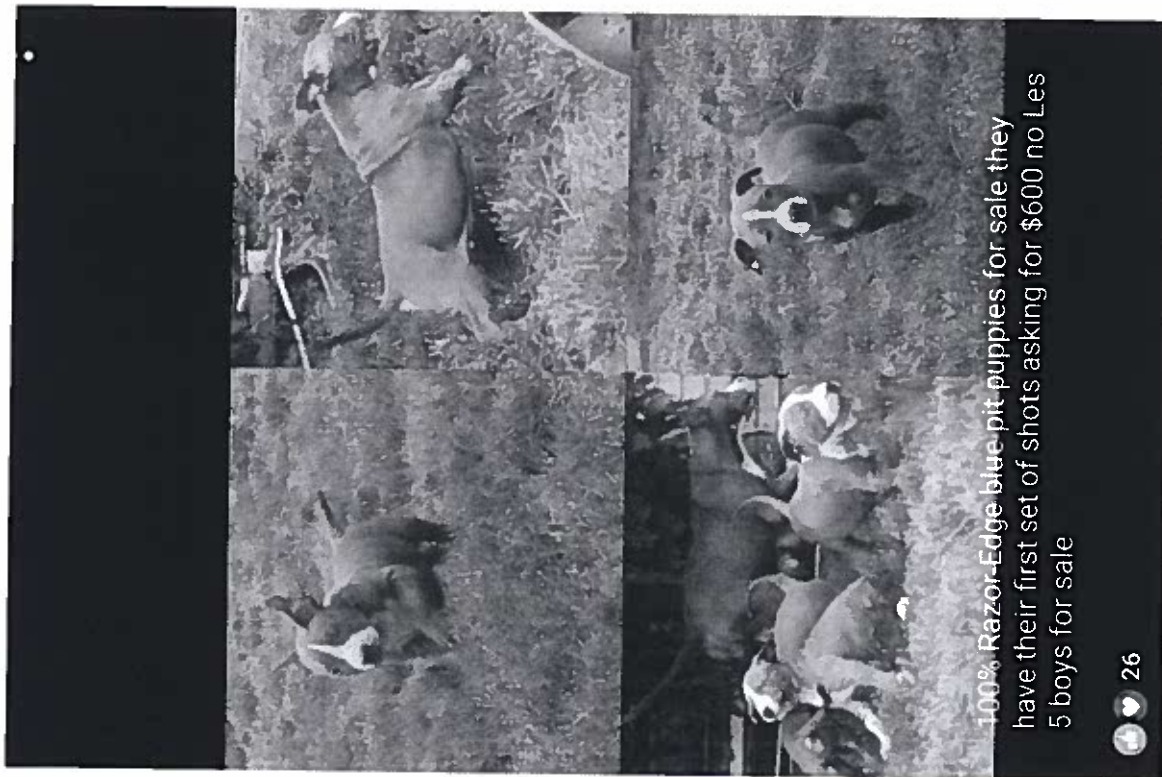

dog training classes with a license!
trainer. They both recieved their
K-9 Good Citizens Certificate from the
AKC. Penelope hasn't recieved hers
yet only because she is used weekly
in training classes with other dogs for
socialization.

My dogs are afraid to come out-
side sometimes now, they will only go
out with my daughter or myself most
of the time. They go to the bathroom
in the backyard and want to run
back up on the porch to come in.

Alley and Penelope have had Separation

anxiety but has gotten worse since TJO took them for 3 days & till we put the kennel up, so they are now on Prozac.

They dogs go around other dogs and people with no issues. Their vet doesn't want a muzzle on them because of their breathing. We never had any calls before these neighbors moved. I have spoken to the police dept., the city, and attorney General regarding some of the issues.
