1. Dangerous Dog Hearing for Two Dogs that Reside at 158 Davis Street

158 Davis-Animal Control Activities

11/25/17-Mr. Brian Bobianski of 143 Russell Street, 01104, was walking his dog "Jax", a Labrador Retriever, when he encountered two loose dogs from 158 Davis Street. One of the dogs, "Bailey", was described as the aggressor. (The second dog is "Zoe", Labrador mix.) "Bailey", a Bull Terrier, owned by Mr. Kevin Doherty, of 158 Davis Street, attacked "Jax" who suffered two punctures on his abdomen. In the scuffle, three people were bitten. Mr. Brian Bobianski, Mr. Kevin Doherty and a neighbor, James Fettes all received minor bites. It was not clear which of the three dogs on the scene bit which person. "Bailey" was placed on a ten day home rabies quarantine, as she was considered by all to be the prime aggressor. All dogs involved are current on rabies vaccinations and licensed.

12/5/17-Mr. Brady Bobianski visited TJO to request copies of the reports and request a dog hearing to determine if the dogs residing at 158 Davis Street are dangerous. It is his request to include both dogs, "Bailey" and "Zoe" in this hearing.

COMMENTS - Current Meeting:

Brian Bobianski, the complainant, stated that he was walking his dog when the Mr. Doherty's dog attacked him and his pet. He stated that Mr. Doherty was extremely apologetic and paid for Mr. Bobianski's medical bills.

Mr. Doherty, the owner, did not dispute that the incident happened. He stated that the dog escaped from his control as he entered the house. He stated that this was purely accidental.

Hannah Chapman, from Animal Control, stated that she believed that this was an accident. The dogs vaccinated, spayed, and up to date of registration.

The board designated the dog "Bailey" as a nuisance by the following vote:

The Board imposed the following conditions:

1. The Owner install a gate at the entrance of the home within one (1) month, that is acceptable to animal control.
2. That both dogs be leashed when ever off of the property.

2. Request for a Dog Hearing of a Dog Named Sage Residing 76 Derby Dingle

Animal control activities for 76 Derby Dingle, 01107

11/23/17-Received an emailed request for a hearing regarding Sage, a Pit Bull type dog that resides at 76 Derby Dingle, 01107. This request came from a USPS carrier Gary Crowley of 50 Cooley Avenue in East Longmeadow, MA, 01028. He has had two incidents of a concerning nature with the dog. Dates of the incidents are 10/25/17 and 11/22/17. MAIL IS CURRENTLY SUSPENDED TO THIS PORTION OF DERBY DINGLE DUE TO RISK OF INJURY TO POSTAL CARRIER.

12/1/17-As of the time of this report, there is no record of rabies vaccination or dog license for this dog.

11/29/17-ACO Perry responded to 76 Derby Dingle to talk with neighbor at 66 Derby Dingle who has had problems with Sage. She went to this address after Johanna from USPS notified TJO of concerns that this resident has.

11/24/17-ACO Sanborn issued citations for unvaccinated dog, unlicensed dog, s/n violation and leash law. Total \$350.00.

10/31/17-ACO Sanborn responded to a report of a frequently loose Pit Bull type dog from 76 Derby Dingle. Nobody was home so a notice was left at the residence.

6/16/15-ACO Robichaud responded to 58 Derby Dingle for a report that a loose, agfgressive white Pit Bull type dog charged at the resident and would not leave the property. Upon arrival, owner was there. ACO issued warning and advised of law.

3/11/15-ACO Terkelsen responded to a report of a losse, aggressive Pit Bull. On arrival, Springfield Police Officers who had also responded had returned the dog, Sage, to owners at 76 Derby Dingle.

11/15/14-ACO Terkelsen responded to a complaint of a frequently loose, aggressive Pit Bull type dog. She made contact with the owner, Madison Pellegrino, who stated dog is off leash for walks. She stated she was only visiting. Owner was advised of the leash law and warned she will receive citations going forward should Sage be loose again.

11/8/14- ACO Robichaud responded to a call at 58 Derby Dingle about an aggressive Pit Bu

COMMENTS - Current Meeting:

Anthony Wilson, committee member, stated that he received an email from Attorney Raipher Pellegrino. The letter stated that the owner could not make the meeting and asked the hearing be continued or that the charges be dropped. The letter also stated that the animal had moved out of the area. The letter was entered into the record.

Pam Pebbles, Director of Animal Control, stated that they were satisfied that the issue was resolved.

The board opened the hearing to the public.

Gary Crowley, the Complainant, stated that he was concerned about the animal and he did not believe that the animal had left the area. He stated that the owner would not answer the door for the police and that the owner has lied about the dog leaving the area in the past.

Attorney Peter Stacy, representing Mr. Crowley, stated that the animal has terrorized the neighborhood.

3. Email from Raipher Pellegrino

4. Request for a Dog Hearing for Two Dogs Owned by Rebecca DelValle (Also May Go by DeJesus) Residing at 175 Glenoak Drive

Animal Control activities regarding 175 Glenoak Drive, Springfield

11/24/17- Received emailed request for a hearing to determine if dogs owned by Rebecca DelValle (or other residents of this address) are dangerous. Request is from neighbors Robert and Deborah Boussy of 165 Glenoak, 01129.

11/22/17-ACO Sanborn responded to a call that the dogs from 175 Glenoak had jumped neighbor's fence and were acting aggressively, slamming themselves against her glass door in an apparent attempt to gain entry. When ACO arrived, dogs were still in their neighbor's yard. They charged the fence with bared teeth when ACO approached fence. The ACO was informed that the owner is a Springfield police officer-Jay Sleeper- so she called dispatch who contacted the owner who came for the dogs. ACO was assured by Mr. Sleeper that dogs were current on rabies vaccinations and licensed, but could not substantiate that. Citations were issued for two unlicensed and unvaccinated dogs. See activity card.

1/25/17-ACO Mateo responded to a concerned citizen's call reporting a stray brindle Pit Bull type dog. Dog was gone when ACO arrived. Neighbor stated she believed the dog lives at 175 Glenoak.

9/17/16- ACO Mateo responded to a concerned citizen's call reporting a stray brindle Pit Bull type dog. Dog was impounded at TJO and claimed by her owner Rebecca Delvalley of 175 Glenoak. The dog was rabies vaccinated and licensed for 2016 prior to leaving TJO.

8/15/13-ACO Charette responded to a report of two loose dogs from 175 Glenoak. She was unable to locate the dogs.

8/8/13-ACO Olszak responded to a report of dogs digging holes into neighbor's yard. The homeowner was not home. ACO left a notice and issued citation for unvaccinated and unlicensed dogs.

3/8/12- ACO responded to a loose dog call and impounded a Cairn Terrier. Dog was identified by owner Miguel DelValle of 175 Glenoak and surrendered to TJO for adoption.
8/2/11-Concerned citizen called to report two dogs outside

Anthony Wilson, committee member, stated that he received a telephone call from Debra Boussey, the complainant, asking to continue the hearing because she could not attend the hearing.

Hanna Chapman, from Animal Control, explained that Animal control officers had observed the dogs loose on the property. The ACO also observed the being very aggressive while still in the owners yard.

Jay Sleeper, the dog owner, stated that his dogs are youthful and playful. He stated that the dogs did escape from his yard once in the past. He stated that the dogs do have a kennel which is where they stay.

Animal control believed that the previous incidents were for a woman owner.

Mr. Sleeper explained that the previous owner is his girlfriend.

Mr. Sleeper agreed that the dogs had dug under the fence and escaped into his neighbor's yard.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion to dismiss the complaint on the condition that the Owner construct a suitable enclosure for the animal within 2 weeks under the supervision of animal control.

Dear Mr. Wilson:

Please be advised this firm and the undersigned represent Lori and Madison Pellegrino in regards to the above referenced matter. As discussed, Madison is the owner of the dog in question ("Saige") and will be residing in the Boston area indefinitely. Madison and Saige were temporarily staying at 76 Derby Dingle while Madison was transferring from Law School in California to Boston. Apparently, Saige figured out how to open the French doors to the home by pressing down on the door handle. During one occasion the mail carrier alleges Saige barked at him while he was delivering mail to the mail box which is located on the house which is a good distance from the road. On the second occasion Lori was present and immediately brought Saige back into the home. Apparently, the mail carrier complained and Lori apologized for any inconvenience. In an effort to accommodate the carrier and alleviate any fears he may have whether founded or not, Lori installed at her own expense a mail box along the street. Lori installed the mail box even though not required to do so to ensure the mail carrier would be comfortable delivering the mail even though she knew Saige was not dangerous and would only be staying there a short period. The road side mail box allowed the mail carrier to deliver the mail without having to exit his truck. Despite her good faith efforts mail services was discontinued to her home and some of her neighbor's homes as well.

Once actual notice of a continued complaint by the mail carrier was received we immediately contacted animal control and provided all of Saige's records requested. Contrary to any assertion made by the mail carrier, Saige is not routinely loose, has never bitten anyone or been aggressive. Lori has lived in the same home for close to 25 years has had other dogs and proven to be a responsible home owner and neighbor. Madison has lived with Saige in San Diego in an inner city condominium complex with other animals and a small bungalow type

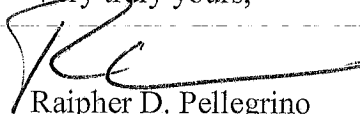

apartment with neighbors in close proximity and there has never been any issue with Saige. In fact both Landlords from San Diego have given positive recommendations regarding Saige for Madison when she applied to rent an apartment in the Boston area.

We certainly appreciate the need to act in a responsible manner and to adhere to the city ordinances, but despite good faith efforts Saige was a little too clever and was able to free herself before Lori and Madison were able to figure out her clever ways. Nevertheless, both incidents complained of by the mail carrier took place on Lori's property which is not in violation of any law or city ordinance.

Madison and Saige are no longer staying in Springfield which should render this matter moot. While we certainly understand the initial complaint by the mail carrier, it should not be forgotten that both the mail carrier and Saige were on Lori's property and Saige did not harm the mail carrier at any time. It appears the mail carrier may have a heightened sensitivity to dogs which may arise from the appearance of Saige or her breed, but it does not make the dog dangerous or aggressive. Again there is absolutely no history to suggest otherwise and despite the mail carrier canvassing the neighborhood to enlist additional complaints, none of any significance has arisen. It should be noted that there is another mail carrier that delivers to the home and has never made any complaint regarding Saige. For the forgoing reasons, I respectfully request that this matter be dismissed. If the Board feels the necessity to conduct a full hearing, I request a continuance to a new mutually convenient date when I can be available to represent my clients as I unfortunately have an engagement in Lowell tomorrow. Thank you for your understanding and sensitivity to this matter.
