- Speakers must sign-up to speak, by the Tuesday before the scheduled meeting, by contacting the School Committee Office at 787-7100 ext. 55191 and must provide their name, address and a description of the topic they will speak about.
- At the start of each scheduled Speak Out, prior to a School Committee meeting, individuals or group representatives who have signed up to speak will be invited by the Chairperson to address the Committee. The length of the public participation segment shall be determined by the Chairperson.
- Speakers will be allowed a maximum of 3 minutes to present their material and, depending on the number of people signed up, this time may be adjusted by the Chairperson.
- Improper conduct and remarks will not be allowed. Defamatory or abusive remarks are always out-of-order. If a speaker persists in improper conduct or remarks, the Chairperson may terminate his/her privilege of addressing the Committee.
- All remarks will be addressed through the Chairperson of the meeting.
- Speakers may offer objective criticisms of the school operations and programs to address their concerns but in public session the Committee will not hear personal complaints of school personnel nor against any member of the school community.
- Written comments longer than three minutes may be presented to the Committee before or after the meeting for the Committee members review and consideration at an appropriate time.
- Speakers may not engage in questioning of the Committee during their speaking time. Speak Outs are scheduled to begin at 6:00 PM and all speakers should arrive by that time.
- All Speak Outs are held at City Hall in room 220.
