II. Public Portion

1. Update from Columbia Gas on gas leak repairs.

Councilor Lederman opened up the meeting for discussion. Several representatives were present from Columbia Gas. They updated the Councilors on the gas leaks and repairs. They are presently working on Grade 2 and 3 repairs, these are less serious repairs. Columbia Gas immediately repairs the most serious leaks which is a Grade 1 repair. They have been working along DPW with road repairs. They will continue to get the work done, hopefully ahead of schedule. The Councilors were pleased with the report given.

2. Discussion on proposed Longmeadow Metering Station.

Councilor Lederman stated that there is a project planned close to Springfield areas. A plan for an enhanced gas line system was discussed in 2014. Springfield natural gas customers get their gas through the lines from Agawam and East Longmeadow. The plan would make improvements to the older pipes.

Councilor Lederman said he would like to hold future meetings with Columbia Gas for updates on this project.
