Meeting of July 10, 2019

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order July 10th, 2019 at 5:32 P.M. Commissioners: Peter Sygnator, Andrew Cade, Rosa Espinosa and Michael Siciliano being present and Ronald Sanes being absent. The meeting was held at Springfield City Hall, 36 Court Street - Room 220-2nd Floor, Springfield, MA.

FIRST order of business –Approval of Minutes:

Approval of Minutes for Springfield Board of License Commissioners Hearing held on Wednesday, June 26, 2019.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to approve with corrections. Motion seconded by Commissioner Espinosa, with unanimous vote to approve.

SECOND order of business-Petitions

Holyoke Market; located at 44 Walsh St; Martin A. Johnson, Event Organizer- One Day Beer and Wine Event; Harambee – July 27th and July 28th 2019 from 12:00 PM-8:00 PM.

Licensee appeared Pro Se.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to approve. Motion seconded by Commissioner Cade, with unanimous vote to approve.

THIRD order of business:

Big D's Jamaican Cuisine located 646 Page Blvd; Donovan Simons, Manager of Record; - Operating without a Common Victualler License.

Licensee did not need to appear.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned to continue generally. Motion seconded by Commissioner Espinosa, with unanimous vote to approve.

FOURTH order of business:-Pre-Hearing Conference:

Moriarty's Pub & Grill located at 755 Liberty St; Michael Moriarty, Manager of Record; Violation of 5-26-19; Security plan-failure to have two security staff on duty, allowing entry after 12:15 am and failure to wand patron with metal detector upon entry.

Licensee appeared Pro Se.

After discussion:

Commissioner Sygnator motioned a suspension of 10 days with 5 days to be served and 5 days to be held in abeyance for 1 year 7-11-19 to 7-10-20. Additionally the boards ordered 3 days that had previously been held in abeyance will be served as a result of this new violation. Motion seconded by Commissioner Espinosa, with unanimous vote to approve.
