Prosed language:

2.16 Safety

I. If a Licensee has a security plan on file with the Licensing Department that provides that the establishment shall maintain security cameras and/or recording equipment (“the system”) on the premises, the Licensee is required to ensure that the system remains in good working order. If the system is not in working order, the Licensee shall notify the Director of Licensing immediately, and in no event more than 24 hours after the system ceases to be in good working order. If the system is not working for more than seven calendar days, an Informational Hearing before the License Commission will be scheduled. At the Informational Hearing, the Licensee will be required to provide details to the License Commission regarding when the system will become operable. Failure to repair or replace the system within 14 days shall result in a violation hearing. The recording device and all cameras shall be tested daily and a log of the tests performed shall be kept. The log shall contain date, time, and signature of tester.
