Councilor Curran asked if this ordinance was in response to the pandemic.

Lederman says the pandemic showed us a new tool to do the work of government.

Councilor Whitfield asked if this proposed policy came directly from the open meeting law. Whitfield asked if the executive order that the governor signed-does it state we have to follow what is in the open meeting law?

President Lederman said the order requires the body would adopt a policy- this policy complies with the open meeting law.

Whitfield believes the council gets more participation via zoom and wants to continue having that option.

President Lederman stated he wants to be even & fair.

Focus Springfield, Brendan Holland, explained that focus Springfield is currently making a plan with Finance and IT to make everything function properly in the chambers.

Councilor Hurst believes we should be as flexible as possible in person/via zoom and asked Atty Moore if we can expand on these requirements.

Atty Moore said it would depends on which expansions - some of the policy is required by Atty Generals Office. (Remote participation is in the body's discretion.)

Councilor Lederman is open to hear all changes to the policy but the open meeting law will require a quorum to be present.

Councilor Hurst believes that the council shouldn't need approval to be out of the chambers from the president.

Atty Moore stated there needs to be someone (the chair) to approve remote participation from one of the members.

Councilor Hurst wants to have more discussion and wants to see this in writing.

Councilor Govan is excited to be back in the chambers.

Councilor Davila and all majority of the council agrees that they should not need permission to participate remotely.

Councilor Whitfield asked about committee meetings-she hosts a lot of them.

Councilor Lederman expects to have fully virtually committee meetings.

Councilor Whitfield made a motion to send to committee, Second by Councilor Hurst.
