WHEREAS, Mass. General Laws ch. 40, section 4A, allows governmental units to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements, subject to the approval of the City Council and the Mayor and/or an officer authorized to execute a contract of each participating governmental body, under certain terms and conditions set forth in the statute; and

WHEREAS, the Massachusetts Department of Transportation ("MassDOT") administers a Federal-Aid grant program that provides Combination Dynamic Speed Feedback and School Zone Speed Sign assemblies to municipalities for installation in existing municipal school zones to enhance roadway safety; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has proposed to install Speed Feedback Signs provided by MassDOT at Duggan Academy on Wilbraham Road in its approved Combination Dynamic Speed Feedback and School Zone Speed Sign Assembly Grant Application; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Locations are within the public right of way in a municipal school zone that conforms with the requirements of Sections 7A.01 and 7A.05 of the 2022 Massachusetts Amendments to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has agreed to install the proposed Speed Feedback Signs at the locations described above; and

WHEREAS, the City hereby requests the City Council and the Mayor to approve this "MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT" in substantially the same form as the draft attached hereto as Exhibit A:

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council hereby approves the "MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT," in substantially the same form as the draft attached hereto as Exhibit A,

There has been an increase in vehicles speeding in front of Duggan Academy, some traffic calming measures need to be put in place. Under this Agreement, MassDOT would like to provide solar-powered combination dynamic speed feedback and school zone speed limit sign assemblies to municipality (ONE ON EACH END OF THE SCHOOL ZONE). MassDOT will procure and provide the equipment to the municipality at no cost. Municipality is responsible for installation and maintenance. Training will be provided by MassDOT and the equipment vendor.
