II. Executive Session

A. *Special Order (SO) #23-028*

The Board intends to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Mass. General Laws chapter 30A, Section 21(a) (1), to discuss and vote whether to hold a hearing (at a future date) regarding the discipline or dismissal of a Springfield Police Department employee in the matter of Special Order (SO) #23-028, unless the employee requests an open session. If the discussion and vote is held in Executive Session, the Board of Police Commissioners will not reconvene in Open Session following the conclusion of Executive Session.

B. *Special Order (SO) #23-009*

The Board intends to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Mass. General Laws chapter 30A, Section 21(a)(1), to hold a hearing to discuss the discipline or dismissal of, or complaints or charges brought against, a public officer, employee, staff member or individual, in the matter of Special Order (SO) #23-009, unless the employee requests an open session. If the hearing is held in Executive Session, the Board of Police Commissioners will not reconvene in Open Session following the conclusion of Executive Session.

The Board will not return to Open Session following the Executive Session.

C. *POST Case #SU-2023-05-03-002 - Continued*

The Board intends to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Mass. General Laws chapter 30A, Section 21(a)(1), to hold a hearing to discuss and vote on the discipline or dismissal of (including the pay status), or complaints brought against, a Springfield Police officer who has been charged with a felony, in the matter of the Peace Officer Training and Standards (POST) Case #SU-2023-05-03-002, which suspended the employee's certification as a police officer as of May 4, 2023. The employee may request that the hearing be held in open session. If the hearing and vote is held in Executive Session, the Board of Police Commissioners will not reconvene in Open Session following the conclusion of the Executive Session.
